Becoming a Safer Place!

Bethel Park has always been an oasis and refuge for many people. Children and youth have always felt it to be a safe place as have their parents. Over the years, our insurance provider has encouraged us to implement policies meant to protect vulnerable people. More recently, our insurance provider has mandated that Bethel Park implement stricter guidelines around the supervision and programming involving the vulnerable sector.

We will be implementing what is known in most of our churches as "Plan to Protect". We have worked to create a specific policy for Bethel Park that is not only very robust but is also workable in our camp setting. At all events where we or our church partners take responsibility for vulnerable people such as at Youth Camp or Kids Camps, or at child and youth focused event during the Retreat Weekends and Family Camp everyone will be required to implement guidelines meant to provide protection for our children and volunteers.

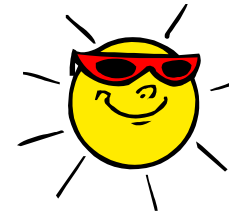
